SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

For the week of July 7-13, 2024 "THE SEALS OF REVELATION"

GETTING STARTED

To the facilitator: Use this section to introduce the topic. If possible, give a brief recap of the sermon.

Share a memorable point, a spiritual lesson, a personal application, a question, or something that challenged you from the sermon last Sunday.

Think about someone you admire for their faith. What qualities do they possess that you would like to cultivate in your own life?

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. Read Matthew 24:29-31, 36-44 and 1 Thessalonians 4:16 5:6. List down the similarities of the two passages. Do you think Jesus and Paul are both talking about the Rapture here?
- 2. (Optional) Revelations 16:12–16 is the record of what will happen toward the end of the tribulation, when an angel pours out the sixth bowl judgment on the earth. The word Armageddon makes its only appearance in the Bible in this passage. In Revelations 19:11–20, is the final battle occurs at Christ's second coming as the conquering Christ defeats the forces of the Antichrist. We take this to be a description of the Battle of Armageddon mentioned in Revelation 16. What are your thoughts about this battle?
- 3. (Optional) Some believe that Matthew 24:29-31 is talking about the Battle of Armageddon and not the Rapture. Based on the readings from Revelations 16 and 19 and comparing it to 1 Thessalonians 4:16-5:10, do you think this is so?
- 4. Read Revelations 6. How do you respond to the breaking of each seal and the events that follow? How should we, as believers, prepare for or respond to these prophetic revelations? Why do you think God is allowing these events to take place?
- 5. Scholars believe the first horseman riding a white horse is the Antichrist (6:1-2). In Daniel 7:8 and 25, we see another description of the Antichrist. What are some of the characteristics of the Antichrist as you see from these passages?

- 6. The fifth seal reveals the souls of martyrs crying out for justice (verses 9-11). How does impact your understanding of the cost of discipleship and the witness of the faithful during that time? What emotions do you think the martyrs were expressing in their cry for justice, and how do you handle feelings of injustice in your own life?
- 7. Overall, do you see a correspondence between Jesus' Olivet Discourse in Matthew 24 and John's description of the opening of the seals in Revelations 6? Do you think there is reasonable evidence to show the timing of the Rapture from these passages?

- ☐ I will cultivate a deeper trust in God.
