SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

For the week of October 21-27, 2024 "THE WORTH OF KNOWING CHRIST"

GETTING STARTED

To the facilitator: Use this section to introduce the topic. If possible, give a brief recap of the sermon.

Share a memorable point, a spiritual lesson, a personal application, a question, or something that challenged you from the sermon last Sunday.

Can you think of a time when you realized that something you wanted wasn't as important as you thought? How did you adjust your priorities?

GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Philippians 3:1-11.

- 1. Rejoice in the Lord always. Paul will repeat this command in Philippians 4.4. What does this mean and how is it even possible to do this "always"? Why does Paul command us to rejoice and not to be happy?
- 2. The people Paul is talking about in verse 2, how were they like dogs? Contextually, Paul was referring to false teachers (probably the Judaizers) who were teaching a form of faith plus works. Why is legalism dangerous to the Christian and how does it steal your joy? Can you think of specific ways that you can be legalistic?
- 3. What kinds of things did Paul have to brag about (verse 4ff)? What is the significance of each of these things? In verse 7, Paul uses the metaphor of an accountant. Who can explain this metaphor?
- 4. What are some things in your life that you tend to hold onto too tightly? Is Paul saying that these things (or relationships) are not important? What is the balance?
- 5. Paul's ultimate goal was to know Christ. How do you think did this would motivate him? What is the difference between knowing Christ and knowing about Christ?

- 6. Paul said he wants share in Christ's suffering (verse 10). Why does Paul embrace suffering? How is suffering connected with knowing Christ? What does a Christian gain from suffering? Is this idea scary for you?
- 7. What specific steps would you need take in the next couple of months if knowing Christ will be your goal?

NEXT STEPS

"Knowing Christ is the greatest thing of all. Why be satisfied with anything else?" ☐ I will be alert for "joy stealers" and legalism. ☐ I will put my confidence only in Christ righteousness. ☐ I will pursue knowing Christ as my goal in life. ☐ I will be a witness for others to see Christ in my life.

- ☐ Go through the devotionals every day this week.
- Have a regular daily time of prayer and reading of God's Word.

- Pray for protection, provision, healing and comfort for everyone who's going through physical, emotional, mental and spiritual pain.
